Police Administration Act

CONSENT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the Minister of the one part and the Northern Territory Police Association Incorporated of the other part, pursuant to section 51 of the Act.

WHEREAS the salaries, allowances and other conditions of service of members of the Police Force are determined by Police Arbitral Tribunal Determination No.1 of 2000 and the Northern Territory Police Force Consent Agreement 2005;

THE PARTIES AGREE that the conditions of service shall be varied to accommodate the following provisions:

1. APPLICATION

This Agreement shall be binding on the Commissioner of Police and the Northern Territory Police Association Incorporated and all members at or below the rank of Superintendent.

2. DISPUTE SETTLING PROCEDURES

In the event a dispute arises in relation to this Agreement, the provisions of Clauses 90 or 164 of Determination No.1 of 2000 shall be used.

3. OPERATION OF THIS AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall operate from the 30 June 2005 and shall remain in force until superseded by a further Determination or Agreement.

4. RELATIONSHIP TO PARENT DETERMINATION AND CONSENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be read and interpreted wholly in conjunction with Determination No 1 of 2000 and the Northern Territory Police Force Consent Agreement 2005, provided that where there is any inconsistency, this Agreement shall take precedence.

5. ACCOMMODATION ENTITLEMENTS

5.1 Determination No.1 of 2000 and the Accommodation Entitlements, ACPO's, Expenses on Transfer and Superintendents 2004 Consent Agreement is varied by inserting the following:

"25.4A Notwithstanding any other provision of Clauses 24 or 25, the Commissioner and the Northern Territory Police Association may enter into written agreement

that a residence is a suitable residence despite it not being in accordance with the Government Employee Housing (GEH) standard.

Such agreement is to have force only where the member to whom the residence is to be supplied agrees in writing to accept the residence as meeting the member's entitlement under Clause 24 or 25.

The written agreement shall remain in force unless superseded by another written agreement between the Commissioner, the Northern Territory Police Association and the member concerned, the member is transferred to another locality or the member's housing entitlement changes.
